

## CLASSES

The Fullerton Institute of Religion adjacent to CSU-Fullerton is a program of religious education provided by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints for all single and married young adults, whether enrolled in college or not. Classes are offered during the day and evening, Monday – Thursday. Come and enroll in a scripture class and we encourage you to take more than one class if you schedule permits.

## PARKING

You will save money by parking at the institute (adjacent to CSUF). The institute parking privilege is free and available to those who are enrolled and have at least 75% attendance in an institute class. You will need to fill out the parking waiver form at the institute to receive your parking sticker and access card.

We have an extensive church library that is available to you. You are free to use any of these books. Please return them after they are checked out through the institute secretary. The library is also a very quiet place to study.

## INSTITUTE COUNCIL
