

# Qualifications for Graduation

A student may qualify for graduation from Institute by completing **14 semester hours of credit**

Required classes:

**4 hours of Book of Mormon courses - 2 credit class**

121 or 421 and 122 or 422

**4 hours of Scripture Based courses - 2 credit class**

Old Testament - 301 or 302

New Testament - 211 or 212

Doctrine and Covenants - 324 or 325

Pearl of Great Price - 327

Doctrine of the Gospel - 430

Teachings of the Living Prophets - 333.

**Six hours** - For the remaining credits they may be from any other Institute classes offered. This may also include duplicate classes that have been taken.

Required classes taken for a diploma must be 2 credit classes. Most classes are two credit hours each, which means graduation is possible with seven classes (or an average of one per semester for four years with allowance to miss one semester).

**Two Special Certificates may be earned with additional 8 credit hours after graduation.**
