



Dance Dress Standards for the South Florida Youth & Young Single Adults

Sunday Dress: Dress pants, dress shirts, dress shoes, tie. Dresses, skirts, blouses, sweaters, dress shoes.

Dressy Casual: Dress pants, shirts or blouses, skirts, sweaters, nice shoes.

Theme Dress: All theme dress will be described in publicity, and must conform to Church Standards. Masks are not allowed.

Dance Dress Standards

All Clothing should be neat, without holes, and within Church Standards

Women:

Skirts should reach the knee when standing. No clothing that is low-cut in front or back, or revealing in any other manner. No tight clothing or other revealing attire. Dresses, blouses or shirts should not be backless, braless, or strapless. No spaghetti straps, halters, bare midriffs, low-cut, open sleeves, or highly slit skirts. No mesh or see-through shirts, half skirts, tank tops, t-shirts, or shorts.

Men

Collared shirts are referred. No tank tops, t-shirts, or shorts. Words on clothing must not be offensive or suggestive. No baggy/saggy pants; pants must be worn at the waist; no underwear should be visible. Hats are not to be worn indoors.
